1. Call to Order
2. Roll Call
 - a. President - Mr. Jason Jacob: Present
 - b. Vice Presidents - Mr. Arne Christian, Mr. Glen Vice, and Mr. Sam Williams: Not Present
 - c. Secretary: Vacant
 - d. Treasurer - Ms. Phyllis Chapman: Present
3. Adopted minutes from 8/4/09 meeting with a modification by Mr. Dino Demarte regarding plans to fix leaning street signs. Mr. Demarte reported that the leaning sign on Fallwood at Summerwood has already been straightened with more signs to be fixed in the coming weeks.
4. Ms. Phyllis Chapman reviewed Association Finances. No concerns were raised.
5. Curbside numbering update: Those residents involved with curbside numbering were not present at meeting.
6. Election of Officers
 - President: Mr. Jason Jacob was nominated and agreed to serve for another year.
 - Vice President: Mr. Dino Demarte agreed to fill the office of Vice President.
 - Secretary: Mr. Stan Shermer agreed to fill the office of Secretary.
 - Treasurer: Ms. Phyllis Chapman agreed to continue as Treasurer.
7. Solicitations: Solicitations are not allowed in the neighborhood. A sign is posted at the entrance of the subdivision. If you are approached by solicitors, please advise them of the rule and ask them to leave.
8. Crime: No issues observed in neighborhood. There was a recent shooting near S. Harrell's Ferry @ George O'Neal. Be aware that some areas susceptible to crime are nearby. Maintaining yards and keeping homes up is a deterrent to crime.
9. Jones Creek Christmas Parade: Last year the Association had a float and placed 8th out of 42 entries. This year the parade will be around December 13, 14; usually 2nd week of December. Those present at the meeting expressed interest in

doing a float again this year. Cappy and Vicky may coordinate as they did last year but will have to be asked if they are interested.

10. Halloween Party: A home LSU game is on Saturday, October 31, 2009 at 7:00 pm. The date set for trick or treating by the city parish needs to be confirmed as meeting attendees speculated that it may be moved to an alternate day due to the LSU game.
Glenda will be asked whether she would like to host the neighborhood Halloween gathering to consist of barbeque, candy distribution, and fellowship.
