

- 1) Glen Vice, called meeting to order
- 2) Toni Wright took roll, in attendance were, VP – Glen Vice, Tres – Phyllis Chapman
- 3) Minutes were adopted from April 7, 2009 meeting
- 4) Announcements/ Guest Speakers
 - James Brown, Ashco Exteriors presented his business and how he can assist homeowners obtain more of a comprehensive claim by using his company as an mediator between you and your insurance co.
 - Sgt. Denise Boudreaux not present, she will be contacted for next meeting
 - Hillary Singleton not present either. Neighbors explained that Sat, May 9th would be “ stamp out hunger day “ and how we can all participate
 - Mail Box discussion.. begun by Mr. Tony Testgilota of Springwood, he interrupted meeting to discuss the notice of meeting and voting issue concerning a community mail box idea.. his opinion was negative toward this idea, as at 83 yrs he felt it would be very difficult to walk to a mail box far from his home, also how would he receive bulk packages. Later in meeting other neighbors voiced concerns over this idea and that mail retrieval would be more cumbersome. The vote was a majority NO to this idea.
Glenda, brought up the discussion of a common look to all mailboxes in the neighborhood. Vicky suggested that Glenda post to the website the information she has obtained about a mailbox and post that Home Depot carries. If people are interested in this they could buy this particular product and install it. It was also suggested that a flier go out for those who could not do the labor themselves, (elderly, a single woman) and that maybe volunteers in the neighborhood would be available to help install the new mailboxes. Many neighbors did not like the idea that our dues would pay to have mailboxes put in for those who had never paid their dues.
The subject was tabled till next month.
- LAWN Service to maintain the front entrance to neighborhood.
Sal presented the quotes he had received. It was discussed, questions asked about to hire comparative bids. The decision was made to have Sal speak with existing service co. to see if they would quote on the work for this year. A vote was taken to give Sal full authority the company to maintain the front entrance for this next year.
- It was reported that a visitor had their purse taken from their car. The car window was open.
- It was voted to strike the Block Party from the agenda.
- Fall Garage sale was discussed and it was voted to drop this subject from the agenda.
- Financial Report: Phyllis reported that we have \$2712.07 in bank. Motion moved to accept financial report. This was done.
- Curb Side Numbers: a Volunteer sign up sheet was passed around and Vicky took responsibility to co ordinate the painting of the curbs. It was decided that a flier would go out first, giving residents the opportunity to communicate if they

did not want their curb painted. If we do not hear from them according to the flier, then all curbs will be painted.

- There was also a volunteer sign up list to help distribute fliers. Glenda took this list.
- Meeting was adjourned.
